



Malacca Heritage Tour 'More than 580 years of history'

Malacca, a UNESCO heritage site which is where it all began for the country. The historic town is a living testimony to the multicultural heritage of traditional Asia and European colonial influences. This is where the western influence started and where many battles has been fought to gain control of this strategic base located between the Eastern and Western world leading to the monopoly and control of the lucrative East Indies' spice trade. When the early European settlers departed, they left behind a treasure enclave of historical buildings and landmarks.

Drive past the largest 17th century Chinese cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit China or Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement.

Proceed to view the famous gateway. 'Port De Santiago' and the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is "Red Square" – the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today house the Malacca Museum and government offices before proceeding for lunch, we visit the 'Abode Merciful Clouds' or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple – the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, viz : Taoim, Buddhism and confucianism. Next proceed to Baba Nyonya Heritage Museum holds the history Baba and Nyonya descendants who have adpsted much of the Malay culture, intermarriage between early chinese settlers and local Malays resulted in the unique Baba Nyonya culture, then take a stroll along Malacca's Jonker Street the centre street of Chinatown – was once renowned for its antique shops. However over the years it has turned to clothing and crafts outlets as well as restaurants, which ends by the banks of the Malacca River.
