



## 3Days 2Nights Kuala Lumpur / Penang / Kuala Lumpur

### Day 1 Kuala Lumpur / Penang (Dinner)

- Pick up at hotel and transfer to Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your pleasant flight to Penang. Upon arrival meet and greet and transfer to hotel for check in
- Freshen up and relax by the poolside overlooking the sea and portions of the mainland – Peninsular Malaysia. In the evening, visit the old colonial landmark – Penang Hill. Experience the new funicular train and upon reaching the top, stroll through a time warp, experience the quaint British colonial styled village
- Dinner alfresco style at David Brown's Restaurant where sitting at the patio is an experience – the sky with the moon and stars above and the city lights of Georgetown and the Butterworth below. After dinner, take the funicular train down and relax as the tour takes you back to the hotel for perhaps a nightcap to end the evening.



### Day 2 Penang (Breakfast/Lunch)

- Breakfast at hotel, proceed to discover the UNESCO HERITAGE SITES of Georgetown in a different mode. Famed for the largest enclave of heritage homes and buildings in South East Asia, Inner Georgetown is a fascinating labyrinth of alleyways and historical sites. Penang's King of the Road, the renowned trishaw (or three wheeled vehicle), has long been the main mode of transport in Penang in the early years till today.
- The trishaws will take you through Campbell Street, with a brief stop at the oldest wet market in Penang, then onto the clan houses along the jetties. Another brief stop to view the proximity of the clan houses to the harbour, where the Chinese migrants lived and work two centuries ago. From there, the trishaw ride continues towards the renowned clock tower which was erected in commemoration of Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee (the height of the tower is 60 ft – 1 ft for 1 year of her reign) and Fort Cornwallis. From Fort Cornwallis, the trishaw ride continues to St George's Church (Anglican), and the High Court, both renowned icons of the British rule.
- From the St George's Church, the trishaw will turn down Farquhar Street and pass by the Penang Museum, the Assumption Church (the oldest Catholic church in Penang) where across the street is oldest Convent in Penang and down the road is St Xavier's Institution, an equally old missionary school in Penang. The schools celebrate their 160 years' anniversary in 2012.
- From St Xavier's Institution, the trishaw ride will turn down Leith Street and onto Muntri Street, the core of the heritage enclave in Penang. Meander through the alleyways and see how innovation has brought the heritage homes back from dilapidated conditions to beautifully restored icons of heritage that are now being used as bed and breakfast home-stays and quaint restaurants.
- At the junction of Stewart Lane, adjacent to the Goddess of Mercy temple, passengers will disembark from the trishaw and begin their walkabout tour of Inner Georgetown, which will encompass the exotic Peranakan Mansion (Peranakan being the fascinating assimilation of twin cultures of Chinese and Malay which has resulted into the quaint Nyonya and Baba heritage), Little India, pass the Kapitan Keling Mosque, onto the famed clanhouse – Khoo Kongsi, and ending up at the little known but equally historical Masjid Jamek at Acheen Street. Lunch will be at a heritage building nearby. After lunch, passengers will be picked up from the restaurant and transferred back to their hotel.
- Evening- Free at Leisure



### Day 3 Penang / Kuala Lumpur (Breakfast)

- Free and easy at leisure till time for check out and departure for airport..
